PRIVACY POLICY

Collection and Use of Personal Data

We are committed to protecting your personal information and to being transparent about the information we hold about you. We use this personal information to communicate with you in a relevant way and we will never share your personal information with any other organisation.

The Ascot, Sunninghill and Sunningdale Neighbourhood Plan Delivery Group (“ASandS NPDG”) collects personal information about its approximately 600 signed up members, to be used solely for the purpose of conducting the following core activities:

- Providing information to individuals or groups of individuals about matters relevant to them as members; namely matters associated with:
 - Planning
 - Existing, proposed or planned new development in the ASandS NP area, neighbouring areas or in the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead
 - Local infrastructure issues
 - Other issues relating to the ASandS NP, its Policies or Projects
 - Issues relating to the Royal Windsor and Maidenhead Local Development Plan, proposed new Local Plan and related matters which impact on our area.
- Distributing updates, reports, survey announcements or results, information on consultations or news relating to or impacting on the ASandS NP area
- Calling notices for any Special Meeting which it is thought appropriate to call
- Conducting surveys or questionnaires amongst the membership

The ASandS NPDG follows the principles of the new General Data Protection Regulations which requires data to:

- Be obtained fairly and lawfully on the basis of consent
- Be held and processed only for the specific purposes listed above
- Be accurate and kept up to date
- Be kept no longer than necessary
- Be made available to data subjects on request
- Be appropriately protected against – unauthorised access, alteration, disclosure and destruction and accidental loss.
